Families Can Receive Financial Assistance for Woonsocket YMCA Day Camps

WOONSOCKET – Thanks to a grant from the Champlin Foundations and a fund-raising campaign, the Woonsocket YMCA has additional money available for summer camp scholarships.

Diane Martin, senior program director for the YMCA at 18 Federal St., said families in need of assistance should apply for the financial aid immediately so their children can enjoy one of the many day camps operated by the YMCA for as long as possible. The Woonsocket YMCA has access to all of the day camps conducted at the MacColl YMCA in Lincoln, which boasts a spray park and a large swimming pool with two slides.

Residents of Woonsocket, North Smithfield and Cumberland are eligible for scholarships and can apply by going to the front desk of the Woonsocket YMCA. Applicants must bring proof of their household income, according to Martin. The YMCA is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.; Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Sunday from 8 a.m. to noon.
